RECIPE

Roasted Carrots with Spinach Green Goddess Dressing

- 2 pounds carrots, washed and trimmed
- 3 tablespoons olive oil, divided
- 2-1/2 teaspoons kosher salt, divided
- 2 anchovy fillets, rinsed, patted dry, and coarsely chopped 1 medium garlic clove, smashed and peeled
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- 1/4 cup Spinach Powder
- 2 tablespoon dried tarragon leaves 2 tablespoons dried chives
- 2 tablespoons freshly squeezed lemon juice
- Freshly ground black pepper, to taste

Preheat oven to 400°F.

Place carrots on rimmed baking sheet. Drizzle with 1 tablespoon olive oil and toss with 2 tablespoons salt. Arrange in a single layer

Roast in oven until tender and beginning to brown, about 20 minutes. Remove from oven and cool to room temperature. Meanwhile, place remaining ingredients, including remaining 1/2 teaspoon salt, in blender and process until smooth, stopping to scrape down sides of blender as needed. Dressing may be thinned with water if needed. Adjust seasoning with with additional salt

and pepper as needed. To serve arrange carrots on serving platter and drizzle with dressing.

Makes 4 servings

The simple act of roasting carrots brings out their natural sweetness and elevates them beyond an ordinary side dish. Green Goddess Dressing has been around since the 1920s, but aside from a brief resurgence in popularity in the late 1970s and early 1980s, it is often overlooked in favor of caesar or ranch dressing. We've updated it with the inclusion of Spinach Powder which gives it a striking green color and a mild, herbaceous flavor.
